 - A. Authorization for Milwaukee County Parks to enter into a Development Agreement with The Park People of Milwaukee County, Inc. (TPP) to make park improvements to Boerner Botanical Gardens (Boerner) by installing brick permeable pavers along the walking paths in the Entrance Area Annual Gardens (\$85,803.38), Shrub Mall (\$63,077.71), and Perennial Garden (\$92,557.27). The total project budget is \$241,438.36 and is fully funded by TPP.
 - B. Existing staff time will be utilized to ensure project is completed to County standards. It is expected that this project will increase operating revenue by approximately \$5,000 annually in future years because the pavers will allow earlier access to the gardens in the spring by at least two weeks because the grounds will be walkable. It is anticipated that maintenance costs will be equal to or less than current maintenance costs.
 - C. No budgetary impacts in the current year because the work will be done after the grounds are closed. Future budget years will see increased operating revenues due to the ability to keep the grounds open for longer periods.
