The approval of the requested action will allow the Interim Director and Chief Information Officer of Information Management Services Division, Department of Administrative Services (DAS-IMSD) to waive 9.05(3) (a) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances. This will allow

Tyler Heater and Maya Zelaya to return to DAS-IMSD as contractors through a temporary staffing agency after leaving Milwaukee County employment as IT Interns.

The direct costs involved for hiring Maya Zelaya as contractor is approximately \$1120.00 per week (based on an hourly rate of \$28.00 per hour) with this being funded through the Asset Protection – Windows 10 Upgrade Project (W0193) budget.
