18 19 20	Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) have been for the expansion of the Oak Leaf Trail, with the idea being that a certain percentage of people will use paved off-road paths for utilitarian trips or for commuting instead of automobiles, if given the opportunity; and
21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, the CMAQ Program is administered by the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation, and is a reimbursement program funded on an 80 percent Federal/20 percent local cost-share basis; and

29 30 31 32	WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of September 10, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-675 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,
33 34 35 36	BE IT RESOLVED, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture is hereby retroactively authorized to submit Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program grant applications for the two projects listed above.
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
