Results will be forwarded to the Medical Review Officer (MRO).7. Please arrive at least 30 minutes before closing time.	<p><u>Preplacement Functional Test:</u></p> <p>Please wear comfortable clothing and exercise shoes.</p> <p><u>Audiogram for Type 40, 50, 60 and 70:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Avoid excessive noise for 14 hours prior to your hearing test. If you must be exposed to excessive noise, please wear hearing protection the day of your test.• You should not have an active ear, sinus or other severe respiratory infection.
