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41 (21) Call-in pay. Employees, who are not exempt from the Fair Labor Standards Act 42 (except hourly, seasonal, and interns), and who are called in to work outside of the employee's regularly scheduled shift, whether on standby or not, shall be paid a 43 44 minimum of four (4) hours pay at the regular overtime rate for work in one (1) session 45 and additional pay at the overtime rate when such hours exceed 40 hours worked in the 46 week. Call-in pay shall not apply to hours worked outside of an employee's regularly scheduled shift where the regular shift starting time is modified to meet emergency 47 48 situations. 49 50 SECTION 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective on May 19, 2019.

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
