Subject: 2020 Contract Recommendations (Revised)

On December 17, 1998, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors adopted File No. 98-197 (a) (a) authorizing the Department on Aging to recommend extension of an existing purchase of service contract without a competitive Request for Proposal (RFP) when based upon (1) satisfactory performance of the vendor and (2) sufficient funding within the Department's adopted budget. That resolution requires that a program be awarded through an open and competitive RFP at least once every three years. Regardless of whether a contract recommendation comes through an RFP or administrative review, the service provider must submit a complete proposal to assure it will meet all budgetary, scope of service, staffing, and other requirements, including local, state, and federal laws and administrative regulations.

There are a couple key factors that the Department uses when selecting how frequently an open and competitive Request For Proposal is conducted for a specific program. First, consideration is given to the potential impact of a new vendor versus continued participation by an existing vendor. Also, does the quality of services provided by the existing vendor continue to meet or exceed expectations?

This year Milwaukee County released RFP#98190016 – Milwaukee County Senior Services 2020. There were four components of this RFP: 1) Programs in the United Community Center, 2) Nutrition Site Supervision Services at the United Community Center, 3) Transportation Services for Older Adults at the United Community Center, and 4) Outreach and Services to Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Older Adults.

Responses to the RFP were reviewed by a pair of evaluation panels. Each panel was composed of two MCDA staff and one member from the Commission on Aging Service Delivery Committee. The panels scored all responses and recommend awarding the following 2020 contracts:
