Mayor Ehley reported on the Operations Committee that met earlier that same day on Sept 9. The committee heard and approved 3 items that were all capital improvements. She also extended congratulations to the City of Cudahy for its Green Luminary award for redesigning Packard Avenue to include water gardens and green infrastructure.
