Informational Report - Update on MCTS NEXT System Redesign Project

BACKGROUND

This report provides a status update on the MCTS NEXT System Redesign Project and proposed next steps. The goals of MCTS NEXT are to update the transit system route network in a way that creates more high frequency service, improves people's accessibility to the places they want to go, and reduces their travel times.

Timeline of Previous Actions

June 2017 – The County Board adopted resolution File No. 17-435 authorizing MCTS to study a 60/40 service delivery option and present findings in a written report to the County Board for review and approval.

September 2018 - MCTS provided the Transportation, Public Works and Transit (TPW&T) Committee with an informational update on the plan to redesign the transit system's route structure, branded as MCTS NEXT (File No. 18-638).

December 2018 - MCTS drafted two service proposals (60/40 and 80/20) to give the public a choice regarding the type of system they would like to see. An extensive outreach plan was prepared to ask riders and stakeholders for their feedback, (i.e., multiple public meetings, on-line and on-board bus surveys, a Spanish language open house, and an on-line virtual open house). There was solid support for increasing the number of high frequency bus routes, and a preference for the 60/40 plan. Consequently, MCTS began to modify its 60/40 route redesign plan in response to specific feedback by passengers and stakeholders.

March 2019 – MCTS provided the TPW&T Committee with an informational update on public outreach efforts of MCTS NEXT (File No. 19-241). Later that month, MCTS presented the modified 60/40 route redesign plan to the public for further review and comment.

May 2019 – MCTS drafted a recommended system map based on public comments on the modified 60/40 plan (Reference File No. 19-27). The recommended system map and other related details can be found at https://www.ridemcts.com/programs/mcts-next/mcts-next-recommended-system-map.

Impact of 2020 Budget on MCTS NEXT

The 2020 Budget currently includes reductions to bus service that were not considered in the scope of MCTS NEXT. As a result, MCTS will wait until the budget is adopted and then update the recommended system map so that service levels fit within the budget.
