A. Section 301.031 of the Wisconsin Statutes requires counties to execute an annual contract with the State Department of Children and Families (DCF) for the "Community Youth and Family Aids Program." This program provides State funding for County services to youth offenders as mandated by State and/or Federal law. The Director, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), is requesting authorization to enter into a 2020 contract with the State for the provision of youth justice services mandated by State law.

- B. The 2020 contract provides \$42,402,102 in Youth Aids funding, which is \$75,823 higher than budgeted in 2020. However, in comparing the actual 2019 to 2020 State contracts for Youth Aids funding, revenue declines by \$20,877 due to the Youth Aids formula which considers youth arrests and placements to the State institutes among other factors. From 2016 to 2018, the number of placements to Lincoln Hills and Copper Lake Schools and the Mendota Juvenile Treatment Center declined by 32 percent.
- C. The additional revenue of \$75,823 will be offset with expenses within the DYFS budget.
- D. No further assumptions are made. The revenue amount is reflected in the State contract.
