A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to execute 2020 Division of Youth and Family Services (DYFS) purchase of service contracts with community vendors.

Approval of this request will allow the Director of DHHS to execute purchase of service contracts to continue the provision of contracted for Prevention & Aftercare, IMP-Aftercare, Targeted Monitoring, Level II Monitoring, Alternative Sanctions, Community Service & Restitution Coordination, and services related to the Residential Treatment Center for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. Shelter Services and the Milwaukee County Accountability Program (MCAP) Act 185 transition planning are recommended for four-month contracts (January 1 to April 30, 2020).

- B. Total 2020 expenditures included in this request are \$8,967,252 (\$8,023,288 for a term of January 1 to December 31, 2020 and \$943,964 for a term of January 1 to April 30, 2020).
- C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request in 2020 as funds sufficient to cover associated expenditures are included as part of the DYFS 2020 Budget.
- D. This fiscal note assumes expenditures will not exceed the amounts authorized for these purchase of service contracts.
