

From the Chief Deputy, Office of the Sheriff, requesting a retroactive extension of the temporary assignment to a higher classification for Mr. Mark Pawlak allowing him to continue to serve in the capacity of Deputy Sheriff Lieutenant for the period effective October 11, 2019 through December 31, 2019, or until the position is filled permanently, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 17.085 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances requires that an extension of Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification (TAHC) beyond 180 days be approved by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Sheriff requests the continuation of Mr. Mark Pawlak's TAHC to the position of Deputy Sheriff Lieutenant from October 11, 2019, through December 31, 2019, or until the position is filled on a permanent basis; and

WHEREAS, the request is being made to maintain consistent leadership at the Patrol Division of the Office of the Sheriff, until the Deputy Sheriff Lieutenant position is filled on a permanent basis; and

WHEREAS, once the Deputy Sheriff Lieutenant position is filled, Mr. Pawlak will return to his permanent position of Deputy Sheriff Sergeant; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of December 4, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-838 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the retroactive extension of Mr. Mark Pawlak's Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification to the position of Deputy Sheriff Lieutenant from October 11, 2019, through December 31, 2019, or until the position is filled.
