Report from the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, requesting approval to allocate anticipated 2020 Community Development Block Grant and HOME funding, by recommending adoption of the following:

AN AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, as part of the annual plan process, a public hearing was held at the meeting of the Committee on Economic and Community Development on October 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, for 2020, a review process was put in place by staff to objectively rank Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) projects based on a scoring system to make final recommendations, and a panel was arranged to score each competitive project based on this system; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Milwaukee County (the County) CDBG allocation totals \$1,603,413; and

WHEREAS, 20 percent of the total funds can be used for administration; and

WHEREAS, 15 percent of the total funds can be set aside for public service projects; and

WHEREAS, the allocation continues to be split between large competitive projects and municipal projects; and

WHEREAS, although the municipal projects were not scored and ranked for the purpose of this report, they are included to show the complete allocation; and

WHEREAS, projects must serve low-to-moderate income individuals within the County CDBG jurisdiction, otherwise the County cannot fund these projects per United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations; and

WHEREAS, the HOME program was born out of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 and was a spin-off of the CDBG Program; and

WHEREAS, the County, as a designated urban county is part of a HOME Consortium with the Cities of West Allis and Wauwatosa; and

 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors' (County Board) approval of the recommendations for the 2020 HOME funding, anticipated to be \$1,705,904, is required to complete the 2020 Annual Action Plan, which is submitted to HUD; and

 WHEREAS, the Wauwatosa and West Allis Consortium member shares are set aside based on their "hold harmless" amounts: and WHEREAS, all recommended CDBG and HOME projects fit the priorities and objectives of the five-year County Consolidated Plan; and WHEREAS, in File No. 93-861, the County established a policy to establish a "limit of a total of three years of funding for any projects in the public service category" for CDBG funds; and WHEREAS, all County CDBG and HOME funds must be spent outside the City of Milwaukee; and WHEREAS, pending County Board approval, the 2020 Annual Plan will be published for a required 30-day comment period and any public comments will then be incorporated into the final 2020 Annual Plan and submitted to HUD for approval; and WHEREAS, in no case will program expenditures exceed available revenue; and projects will be adjusted on a percentage basis if the final award from HUD differs from the County's funding amounts; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Economic and Community Development, at its meeting of December 9, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-892 as amended (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) authorizes the Director, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), or her designee, to change the Community Development Block Grant Funding (CDBG) allocation policy to remove the limitation that non-profit public services projects can only receive three consecutive years of CDBG funds to give the County Board more flexibility with its allocations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board authorizes the Director, DHHS, or her designee, to allocate the total anticipated 2020 CDBG and HOME funds to the following projects:
