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From the Executive Director, Department on Aging, requesting authorization to increase the existing purchase of service contract with the United Community Center by \$10,000, from \$746,378 to \$756,378, for senior center programming, congregate meal programming, and transportation service for older adults, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2018, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors authorized the Executive Director, Department on Aging (Aging), to execute contracts to provide programs and services to older adults for the period effective January 1, 2019, through December 31, 2019 (Adopted File No. 18-897); and

WHEREAS, one program authorized under Adopted File No. 18-897 was transportation, senior center, and meal programming for older adults provided by United Community Center (UCC); and

WHEREAS, based on the growing need by Milwaukee County seniors for these services, the actual cost of these services provided by UCC under its 2019 contract has exceeded \$756,378; and

WHEREAS, Aging has identified \$10,000 remaining in the 2019 State and County Contract covering social services and community programs – aging programs available for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, authorizing an increase to the 2019 UCC contract by \$10,000, from \$746,378 to \$756,378, enables Aging to partially reimburse UCC for costs incurred in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of December 12, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-822 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Executive Director, Department on Aging, is hereby authorized to increase by \$10,000, from \$746,378 to \$756,378 the 2019 contract award to United Community Center to provide transportation, meal, and senior center services for older adults.
