WHEREAS, the County, in coordination with Willis of Wisconsin, MCTS, and the City of Milwaukee, evaluated a proposal for a three-year contract renewal; and

WHEREAS, United Healthcare's combination of administrative costs and network access provide the optimal financial performance available to the County and MCTS' health plans; and

WHEREAS, the pharmacy pricing terms offered by Optum Rx continue to lead the market; and

WHEREAS, United Healthcare and Optum Rx combined together to provide efficient, high-quality coverage options that the County and MCTS have designed for its active employees, pre-Medicare, and Medicare-eligible employees; and

WHEREAS, United Healthcare has a successful track record of complying with and exceeding the County's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goals; and

WHEREAS, United Healthcare was found to be uniquely positioned, by virtue of the strength of their provider network contracts in the greater Milwaukee area, to administer the health plans for the County, MCTS, and the City of Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of December 12, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-931 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,
