AT THIS LATE MOMENT, I HAVE DECIDED TO NOT ATTEND THE MEETING BECAUSE I AM CONTAGIOUS WITH A SEVERE RESPIRATORY COLD AND I DON'T WANT TO INFECT ANYONE.

T AM HUDING THAT THIS HANDWRITTEN LETTER REGARDING THE KLETZSCH PARK WATERFALL AND THE PROPUSED FISH PASSAGE IN THE MILWAUKEE RIVER IS HELPFUL.

TN ADDITION TO MY BEING A RIPARIAN SWNER OF
THREE ACRES ON THE RIVER 133 FEET DOWNSTREAM
FROM THE WATERFALL, I AM PRESIDENT OF THE FRIENDS
OF KLETZSCH PARK, A GROUP OF 260 PLUS MEMBERS
WHO ARE ALL VERY CONCERNED WITH THE MATTER OF
A FISH PASSAGE. I SPEAK FOR THE MAJORITY OF
OUR MEMBERS, AND OTHERS, WHO HAVE EXPRESSED
AN OPINION ON THE LOCATION OF A FISH PASSAGE.

WESTSIDE PASSAGE BY MILWAUREE COUNTY PARKS
DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL, THE MASSIVE SCOPE OF
THIS FIRST PROPOSAL WAS NOT WELL RECEIVED BY
ANYONE THAT I HAVE SPOKEN WITH INCLUDING THE
MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF GLENDALE.

THE REQUEST WAS MADE BY MANY TO THOROUGHLY EXPLORE A LESS INVASIVE ROUTE FOR THE PASSAGE AROUND THE WATERFALL ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE RIVER. INITIALLY, THERE WERE TOUG, NOW-RESIDING LAND OWNERS THAT WERE HESITANT ABOUT AN EAST SIDE PRSSAGE. I AM TOLD THAT THEY HAVE WITHDRAWN THEIR PRIOR OBJECTIONS, THAT HAS RESULTED IN A NOW UNANIMOUS APPROVAL OF AN EAST SIDE PASSAGE. THAT ROUTE INTERCEATS THE RIVER ABOVE THE WATERFALL, PROCEEDS ACROSS A LOT OWNED BY CITY OF GLENDALE, AND THEN OVER THE LOT CHINED BY TWO GLENDALE CITIZENS, NEITHER OF WHICH RESIDE THEREON, AND THENCE ACROSS TWO LOTS OWNED BY MILWAUKEE COUNTY AND THEN BACK INTO THE RIVER JUST BELOW THE WATEREALL, SPANNING FISH WOULD HAVE A ROUTE AROUND THE WATER FALL TO WATERS ABOVE,

WHEN WE FIRST ASKED THE PARKS DEPARTMENT TO

EXPLORE THIS SIMPLE SOLUTION, WE WERE TOLD THAT

THE TWO LANDOWNER, FORHER OBJECTORS, PREVENTED THIS,

EVEN THOUGH ONLY ONE OF THEM ACTUALLY OWNED THE

PART OF THE LOT TO BE CROSSED. AS SHOW, IT APPEARS

THAT THERE ARE NO LONGER ANY OBJECTORS AMONG

THE EASTSIDE LANDOWNERS.

THEN, WE WERE TOLD THAT THE PARKS DEPARTMENT CONSULTANTS "MODEL" INDICATED THAT ANY EASTSIDE ROLITE WOULD RESULT IN A BACK-UP OF WATER ABOUT



THE MARKELLE WATERFALL, DURING A 100 YEAR ELOOD EVENT, THAT WOULD BE CONTRARY TO A "MANDATED" LEVEL.

THIS CONTENTION WOULD HAVE US BELIEVE THAT WATER CAN FLOW UPHILL IF NOTHING ELSE WAS INTRODUCED TO THE PHYSICS OF THE MATTER. WE KNOW OF NO OTHER INGREDIANT THAT WOULD FACTOR INTO PLAY,

LACK OF ACCESS WAS THEN CLAIMED TO BE A FACTOR.
SUNNY POINT LANE IS A LEGAL ACCESS THAT PREVIOUSLY
ALLOWED HEAVY MACHINERY TO TAKE DOWN A HOUSE,

YOUR CHOIRMAN, THEO LIPSCOMB, INSPECTED THE LAND OWNERSHIPS ON SITE AND CONCLUDED THAT THE EAST SIDE PASSAGE SHOULD BE CONSIDERED.
