- A. The Chief Deputy of the Office of the Sheriff is requesting the creation of one (1.0) FTE Jail Population Analyst. This position will be housed in the Office of the Sheriff's Administration Bureau, Law Enforcement Analystics Division and will support the work of the Milwaukee County Community Justice Coordinating Council.
- B. The funding for the position will last two years (2020-2021) and will come from Phase III of the MacArthur Foundation sponsored Safety and Justice Challenge Grant. Following this two year period, the position will be reduced or eliminated based on grant funding. The Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office will be reimbursed by Combined Court Related Operations for the actual expenditures related to this position through a journal voucher (JV).
- C. The position will be hired in pay grade 26M and the total cost of the position, approximately \$59,228 in 2020 (assuming pay period 3 or 4 hire) and \$63,967 in 2021 (full year) will be funded by Phase III of the MacArthur Foundation sponsored Safety and Justice Challenge Grant. There is no tax levy impact from the creation of this position.
