Amend the final BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED clause and add two additional BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED clauses as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Milwaukee County, if it chooses to, may be able to exceed the State of Wisconsin property tax levy limits in order to pay the unreimbursed expenses related to the public health emergency: ; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Department of Administrative Services, working in conjunction with Office of the Comptroller, the Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS), and other applicable departments, are authorized and requested to identify essential employees that, in order to do their jobs, cannot adhere to the State of Wisconsin's "Safer at Home" Order to reduce further spread of COVID-19 for possible additional pay and/or more Supplemental Paid Leave (SPL) if they contract the virus; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Administrative Services shall provide a report to the County Board by April 2, 2020, as to the recommended steps to ensure that the essential, public-facing employees of Milwaukee County and MCTS are protected so they can continue to provide critical services.
