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BE IT RESOLVED, Milwaukee County (the County) is committed to mitigating, however possible, the extent of the economic disruption caused by coronavirus disease (COVID-19) to its citizens and employees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) hereby authorizes the receipt of \$62,044,048 in Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, funding provided by the Federal government and requests that the Office of the Comptroller shall secure the funds in a designated account to ensure they are segregated from other funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby requests that the Office of the County Executive prepare and develop a plan for the appropriation of the \$62,044,048 million received from the Federal government in response to COVID-19; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the plan shall reflect the County's commitment to safely keeping citizens and employees working, stimulating the local economy, and adherence to public health guidelines; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the plan shall be submitted to the County Board for review and approval before funds are committed or allocated.

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
