

From the Chief Human Resources Officer, Department of Human Resources, requesting approval to modify the Premium Pandemic Pay Administrative Order for the authorized positions specified in the updated Administrative Order until June 9, 2020, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2020, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) adopted File No. 20-359, which approved Administrative Order 20-12v2 issued by the County Executive, to provide Premium Pandemic Pay Compensation to certain employees who support operations with increased risk and exposure to coronavirus disease (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, the resolution directed that any proposed changes to the Premium Pandemic Pay Compensation be submitted to the County Board for review and approval; and

WHEREAS, on May 27, 2020, the County Executive issued Administrative Order 20-12v3 to extend the original order through June 9, 2020, and add additional positions to the list of employees eligible for the Premium Pandemic Pay Compensation; and

WHEREAS, the list included nine additional positions, eight of which are assigned to the Behavioral Health Division, Department of Health and Human Services, and per 2013 Wisconsin Act 203, under the exclusive authority of the County Executive and Milwaukee County Mental Health Board; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of June 17, 2020, recommended adoption of File No. 20-449 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) hereby approves one additional position of Human Services Worker for Youth Detention in the Department of Health and Human Services to the list of positions eligible for the supplemental pay as outlined in Administrative Order 20-12v3, hereto attached to this file; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board approves the extension of the Premium Pandemic Pay Compensation for the authorized positions until June 9, 2020, as specified in the updated Administrative Order.
