From the Director of Milwaukee of County Parks, requesting retroactive authorization to apply for and accept grants from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program and Fund for Lake Michigan, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the lagoon in Veterans Park has experienced an outbreak of unhealthy algae blooms; and

WHEREAS, initial attempts to dissipate and discourage the blooms by the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) partnership with the City of Milwaukee (the City) have been unsuccessful; and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that more information is necessary to formulate a plan to remedy the health of the lagoon; and

WHEREAS, DPRC, in collaboration with the City, and the Milwaukee County Environmental Services Section, Facilities Management Division, Department of Administrative Services, have designed a plan for collecting data in hopes to facilitate a plan to remediate the lagoon; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of June 18, 2020, recommended adoption of File No. 20-419 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) is hereby retroactively authorized to apply for grant funding from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program (WCMP), and Fund for Lake Michigan in support of the project entitled "Restoring Water Quality in a Coastal Urban Lagoon Environment;" and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DPRC is authorized to accept awarded funding from the WCMP, in the amount of \$78,022 and the Fund for Lake Michigan in the amount of \$52,353; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the DPRC, the Office of the Comptroller, and Department of Administrative Services are authorized to execute administrative fund transfers to implement the awarded grant funding.
