1 2 File No. 20-465 3 A resolution by the Committee of Finance, relating to an informational report regarding 4 5 the Coronavirus Relief Fund Allocation, by recommending adoption of the following: 6 7 A RESOLUTION 8 WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, Governor Evers declared a public health 9 emergency in response to local cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) across the 10 State of Wisconsin (State), and as of June 16, 2020, there have been almost 9,700 11 confirmed cases in Milwaukee County (County) to-date with 322 deaths; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, the County seeks to be proactive to contain the spread of the virus and has received Federal and State of Wisconsin (the State) funding to help in those 15 efforts: and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board), at its 18 meeting on May 14, 2020, adopted File No. 20-360, which authorized the receipt of 19 20 \$62,044,048 in Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act -Coronavirus Relief Funds, and requested the County Executive to develop a plan for the 21 appropriation of the funds to be reviewed and approved by the County Board; and 22 23 WHEREAS, on May 27, 2020, Governor Evers announced the "Routes to 24 Recovery: Local Government Aid Grants" program, which provides an additional 25 \$15,384,444 in CARES Act - Coronavirus Relief Funds to the County; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the County's total allocation of CARES Act - Coronavirus Relief 28 Funds is now \$77,428,492, including \$62,044,048 received from the Federal government 29 and an additional \$15,384,444 from the State; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, File No. 20-335 was approved by the County Board authorizing and 33 directing the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) and the Office of the Comptroller to provide an administrative appropriation transfer of \$20,000,000 from the 34 \$62,044,048 in CARES Act funds received to establish a separate Org. Unit in DAS so 35 36 the funds already expended by departments due to the COVID-19 pandemic can be 37 charged (transferred) against these funds to better account for these expenses and improve financial oversight of departments; and 38 39 WHEREAS, DAS, with oversight by the Comptroller, are authorized and directed 40 to provide monthly reports to the County Board detailing departmental expenses that 41 have been charged to the COVID-19 grant fund; and 42 43 WHEREAS, DAS will report expenditures that have been incurred and which are 44 45 recommended to be charged against the CARES Act for review and approval; and

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WHEREAS, grant funding (Federal/State/Other) is available to help offset the 47 COVID-19 costs incurred by the County; and 48 49 50 WHEREAS, the report hereto attached to this file provides a framework for planned spending against the overall \$77,428,492 grant award; and 51 52 WHEREAS, \$10 million is earmarked to begin the Housing and Homeless 53 Services portion of the plan to help reduce evictions and to help house individuals with 54 housing insecurities; and 55 56 WHEREAS, DAS will continue to provide expenditure reports and spending 57 updates on a monthly basis; and 58 59 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of June 18, 2020, 60 recommended adoption of this By the Committee Resolution associated with File No. 61 20-465 (vote 7-0); now, therefore, 62 63 BE IT RESOLVED, the Director, Department of Administrative Services, is 64 authorized to accept \$15,384,444 in additional Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic 65 Security (CARES) Act funding from the State of Wisconsin, which was awarded under 66 the "Routes to Recovery" program; and 67 68 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Office of Performance, Strategy, and Budget, 69 Department of Administrative Services (OPSB-DAS), and the Office of the Comptroller 70 (Comptroller) are authorized and directed to provide an administrative appropriation 71 transfer of \$10 million in CARES Act funds into the Org. Unit established in File No. 72 20-335 that, coupled with the earlier transfer of \$20 million, would establish a total 73 budget of \$30 million to cover eligible expenses to address the coronavirus disease 74 (COVID-19) pandemic; and 75 76 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, an appropriation of \$10 million shall be earmarked 77 for the Housing and Homeless Services programs outlined in the report hereto attached 78 to this file, which includes: \$7,000,000 for eviction prevention, \$2,000,000 for housing 79 acquisition, and \$1,000,000 for mortgage assistance; and 80 81 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors 82 (County Board) authorizes up to \$700,000 to be spent on administration of the eviction 83 prevention program, including contract support from partner agencies; and 84 85 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby requests the balance of 86 the COVID-19 grant funds, \$47,482,492, be reserved for allocation in a subsequent 87 meeting cycle to best address the needs of the community and the citizens that have 88 been adversely impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic; and 89 90

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DAS shall provide monthly reports to the County 92 Board detailing expenses charged to the COVID-19 grant funds as well as updates on 93 the programs funded with these monies. 94

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
