- A. Approval of this resolution will reallocate the position of Director Election Commission from pay grade 901E to 902E effective retroactively to the first pay period in 2020. The incumbent will move from \$78,645 in 901E to \$85,467 in 902E.

- B. This request is to reallocate the Director Election Commission to the proposed Pay Grade of 902E retroactive to the first pay period in 2020. The increased salary and Social Security cost will be \$7,344 in 2020 and \$7,344 in 2021.
- C. The Election Commission has identified funds in its Commodities and Services budget to fund the change in 2020. A fund transfer from Commodities and Services to the Personnel accounts in the 2020 Election Commission budget will be requested in the resolution to cover the cost of this reallocation.
