Approval of this resolution would call upon the State of Wisconsin to explicitly make it a hate crime in hate crime statutes should someone mislead a law enforcement officer based on several identities including race. The resolution further calls upon the National Sheriffs' Association to implement unconscious bias trainings to local Neighborhood Watch groups and others. Locally the resolution calls for the Milwaukee County Intergovernmental Cooperation Council and all Milwaukee County police departments and their police and fire commissions to likewise implement unconscious racial bias trainings to Neighborhood Watch and other groups, but also to ensure police departments are capable and empowered to mitigate negative outcomes derived from non-emergency, non-issue racially biased calls for police service.
- B. There are no direct costs associated with this resolution. Existing staff time would be needed to communicate the contents of the resolution to Wisconsin policymakers, the National Sheriffs' Association, the Milwaukee County Intergovernmental Cooperation Council, and all Milwaukee County police departments and their police and fire commissions.
- C. No budgetary impacts are expected in this or subsequent years. The resolution would not authorize the expenditure of any additional funds.
- D. No assumptions were made.
