 - A. Milwaukee County Parks is presenting the Verizon License Agreement for consideration by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors. If the County Board chooses to approve the license agreement, Milwaukee County Parks will enter into a ten (10) year license agreement with five (5) options to renew for five (5) year periods if mutually agreeable to both parties. Approval of this agreement would allow Verizon to locate one Small Wireless Facilities (SWF) at Veterans Park and one SWF at McKinley Park.
 - B. Anticipated revenues are \$270 per year for each pole. The rates may be increased by ten (10) percent as of July 10, 2024, and every five years thereafter, rounded to the nearest multiple of five dollars.
 - C. Approval of this license agreement will increase revenues in 2020 by \$270 (prorated for half the year) and each year thereafter at \$540 with the ability to increase the \$270 fee per pole by ten percent as of July 10, 2024, and every five years thereafter for the life of the agreement which upon execution of all mutually acceptable renewals will be a total term of 35 years.
