A. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting to create 1.0 FTE Community Intervention Specialist position supported by grant funding.

B. DHHS will receive additional federal funding through a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) that will cover the increased expenditures for 1.0 FTE Community Intervention Specialist in the Housing Division to provide assistance to approximately 64 homeless individuals and families through the division's Rapid Rehousing program.

The new 1.0 FTE Community Intervention Specialist position would be at grade 24, with a pay range of \$52,541 - \$61,309 for salary (\$56,567 - \$66,000 with salary and social security). The DHHS assumes filling the positions in Pay Period 22 but does not assume filling at a particular step. The direct cost (salary and social security) impact in 2020 includes actual expenditures of \$14,050 for 1.0 FTE Community Intervention Specialist position (if filled at step 3), offset by HUD revenues of \$14,050.

The annual direct cost impact for the salary and social security costs of 1.0 Community Intervention Specialist position filled at step 3 in pay grade 24 is \$60,880.

C. The direct cost impact in 2020 to create 1.0 FTE Community Intervention Specialist position is approximately \$14,050. Grant revenue from HUD will cover the direct costs.

D. Assumptions include: Filling the 1.0 FTE at step 3 in pay period 22 and receipt of grant revenue from HUD.
