If adopted, this resolution would authorize and direct the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture to change the name of Wahl Park to Harriet Tubman Park and processing a fund transfer request in the amount of \$9,750 from Org. Unit 1800-1945 Appropriation for Contingencies to an appropriate account within Org. Unit 9000 Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture.
- B. Adoption of this resolution would require new signage in the Park, at an estimated one-time cost of approximately \$9,750. Because the Department's 2020 Adopted Budget does not include funding for this initiative, monies from the Appropriation for Contingencies would need to be transferred to the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture to cover the cost of new signage. Existing staff time is also needed to procure and install the new sign.
- C. There is a budgetary impact of \$9,750. The resolution authorizes the Department of Administrative Services to process a transfer from the Appropriation for Contingencies to cover the cost of the new signage. There are no additional costs anticipated for subsequent years.
- D. No assumptions or interpretations were used.
