- A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to execute amendments to purchase of service contracts with Community Advocates, Inc. and UMOS, Inc. to operate the Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) for the period beginning October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021.

Approval of the request will permit DHHS to administer the Energy Assistance Program and ensure the continued availability of electric and heating bill payment assistance as well as benefits and services to assist with energy crisis situations to eligible low-income households in Milwaukee County.

B. Total expenditures included in this request are \$148,149.

- C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request as funds sufficient to cover these expenditures are supported by the FFY2021 State WHEAP contract which reflects total revenue of \$2,583,252. The cost of the contracts was included in the 2020 Adopted and 2021 Budgets for Energy (in low org 8238). The WHEAP funds also cover the county's administrative costs in addition to the two provider contracts.
- D. It is assumed that total expenditures will not exceed the contract amount unless additional revenue is received.
