 - A. Authorization to enter into an Interagency Agreement with the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System on behalf of the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee in the amount of \$129,523 for continued data collection in Veterans Park Lagoon. In County Board File No. 20-419 Milwaukee County Parks requested permission to apply for and accept grants from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program and the Fund for Lake Michigan to formulate a plan to remedy the health of the Veterans Park Lagoon. This grant application was a collaboration between Milwaukee County Parks, the City of Milwaukee, and the UW-Milwaukee. It was determined in the grant application that UW-Milwaukee would be responsible for data collection and this is the resulting contract.
 - B. The contract is for \$129,523 and is covered by the grants that Milwaukee County Parks was authorized to apply for and accept per County Board File No. 20-419. Existing staff time will be utilized as this is a collaboration to improve the health of Veterans Park Lagoon.
 - C. Sufficient funds are budgeted because the contract will be paid out of the grants received from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program and the Fund for Lake Michigan.
 - D. No assumptions or interpretations were utilized.
