6 **A RESOLUTION**

8 WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020, Combined Court Related Operations submitted a  
9 grant application to the Bureau of Justice Assistance, seeking \$500,000 in funding for  
10 three years to enhance the Adult Drug Treatment Court and Veterans Treatment Court  
11 programs; and

12  
13 WHEREAS, the application included \$96,000 for continued program research  
14 and evaluation by the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, the application included \$39,414 for continued peer mentoring  
17 coordination through the Center for Veterans Issues; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the application included enhanced and consistent drug testing for  
20 participants and availability of Secure Continuous Remote Alcohol Monitoring for  
21 appropriate participants; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, the application included enhanced resources for holistic services  
24 and sober living for participants; and

25  
26 WHEREAS, the application included funding to support training for the Adult  
27 Drug Treatment Court, and Veterans Treatment Court teams; and

29 WHEREAS, on October 16, 2020, Combined Court Related Operations received  
30 a funding award notice for the Adult Drug Court, and Veterans Treatment Court  
31 Discretionary Grant Program-Category 3 in the amount of \$500,000, from the Bureau of  
32 Justice Assistance; and

34 WHEREAS, the award period is from October 1, 2020, to September 30, 2023;

37 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 10, 2020,  
38 recommended adoption of File No. 20-914 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

40 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby  
41 authorizes the Chief Judge, First Judicial District, Combined Court Related Operations,  
42 to accept the Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant Award for the Adult Drug Treatment  
43 Court, and Veterans Treatment Court Discretionary Grant Program-Category 3, in the  
44 amount of \$500,000 for the provisions of: drug testing, Secure Continuous Remote  
45 Alcohol Monitoring, holistic services, sober living, peer mentoring, training, and  
46 evaluation to further support the programs.
