Report from the Interim Executive Director, Department on Aging, requesting authorization to amend 2020 nutrition services purchase of service contracts, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Department on Aging (Aging) administers Senior Dining Programs to address food insecurity, and the need for nutritious balanced meals for residents over age 60 in Milwaukee County (the County); and

WHEREAS, Aging works with several vendors and caterers that have expertise in nutrition and culturally appropriate meal planning; and

WHEREAS, Aging has identified \$100,000 of the funds allocated to the County from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, available for a one-time funding increase to these programs, in response to the economic fallout of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic; and

WHEREAS, authorizing an increase to the 2020 meal site supervision services contracts by \$100,000 enables Aging to partially reimburse vendors for costs incurred in 2020, and to support increased meal demand as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Health and Human Needs, at its meeting of October 28, 2020, considered File No. 20-742 for informational purposes only; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 10, 2020, recommended adoption of File No. 20-743 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Interim Executive Director, Department on Aging, is hereby authorized to execute amendments to 2020 contract awards in the amount of \$100,000, with the following meal site supervision service vendors for the period January 2020, through December 2020, in the amounts enumerated as follows:
