- A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to amend 2020 Disabilities Services Division purchase of service contracts with Birth to 3 agencies.
- B. Approval of this request will reallocate existing funding of \$65,000 from one Birth to 3 provider due to underspending to two other Birth to 3 providers. The total amount originally allocated of \$4,887,615 for Birth to 3 provider services remains the same.
- C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request as funds sufficient to cover the associated expenditures are budgeted in 2020. These contract amendments would enable the program to meet its federal Maintenance of Effort (MOE) requirement.
