Employ Milwaukee Community Resource Navigator Program

Employ Milwaukee (EMI) in partnership with the City of Milwaukee Community Development Grants Administration, Milwaukee County and WRTP/BIG STEP, trained, employed, and deployed more than 300 individuals to community- and faith-based organizations, public health authorities, shelters, isolation facilities and other government agencies to provide humanitarian efforts to:

- Mitigate the spread of COVID-19 through the distribution of public health information and resources
- Deliver medicine, food, clothing, shelter, and supplies to older or at-risk individuals
- Aid in contact tracing
- Provide information on how to access mental health resources to individuals suffering from significant additional psychological stress and anxiety about the ongoing public health concerns and their risk of exposure
- Provide information on how to access unemployment benefits, dislocated worker resources, or current job openings

These positions:

- Paid individuals \$17/ per hour
- Had a maximum duration of 6 months
- Were Part time but include supportive services such as transportation and childcare
- Included specialized training on * Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) by City of Milwaukee * Center for Disease Control (CDC) specific COVID-19 recommendations, Financial Literacy Courses, and Community Health Care Worker Training. form)

Impact for the Community Resource Navigators (CRNs):

Many of the individuals hired as CRN's were those adversely impacted by COVID-19, long term unemployed, and individuals that were waiting on unemployment compensation. Individuals were thankful for this opportunity as it served as an economic resource to maintain households during a very difficult time.

Impact for the Work Site Organizations:

Placements of CRN's within the community organizations was critical to maintain the services that they rendered. Many of these organizations would not have been able to maintain the volume of the demand and need without the extra staff supplied and supported through this program.

Continuum of Care: For those individuals who met their maximum duration, EMI reached out and provided the following services:

- Education and Training Resources
- Community Resources – based upon a needs assessment screening at intake
- Referrals to WIOA Programming
- Information about Job Center of Wisconsin Website www.jobcenterofwisconsin.com
- Current Job Openings and Opportunities

The program has been a great success. The demand was high, the community needs still exists, and EMI continues to seek funding partnerships to continue the program.

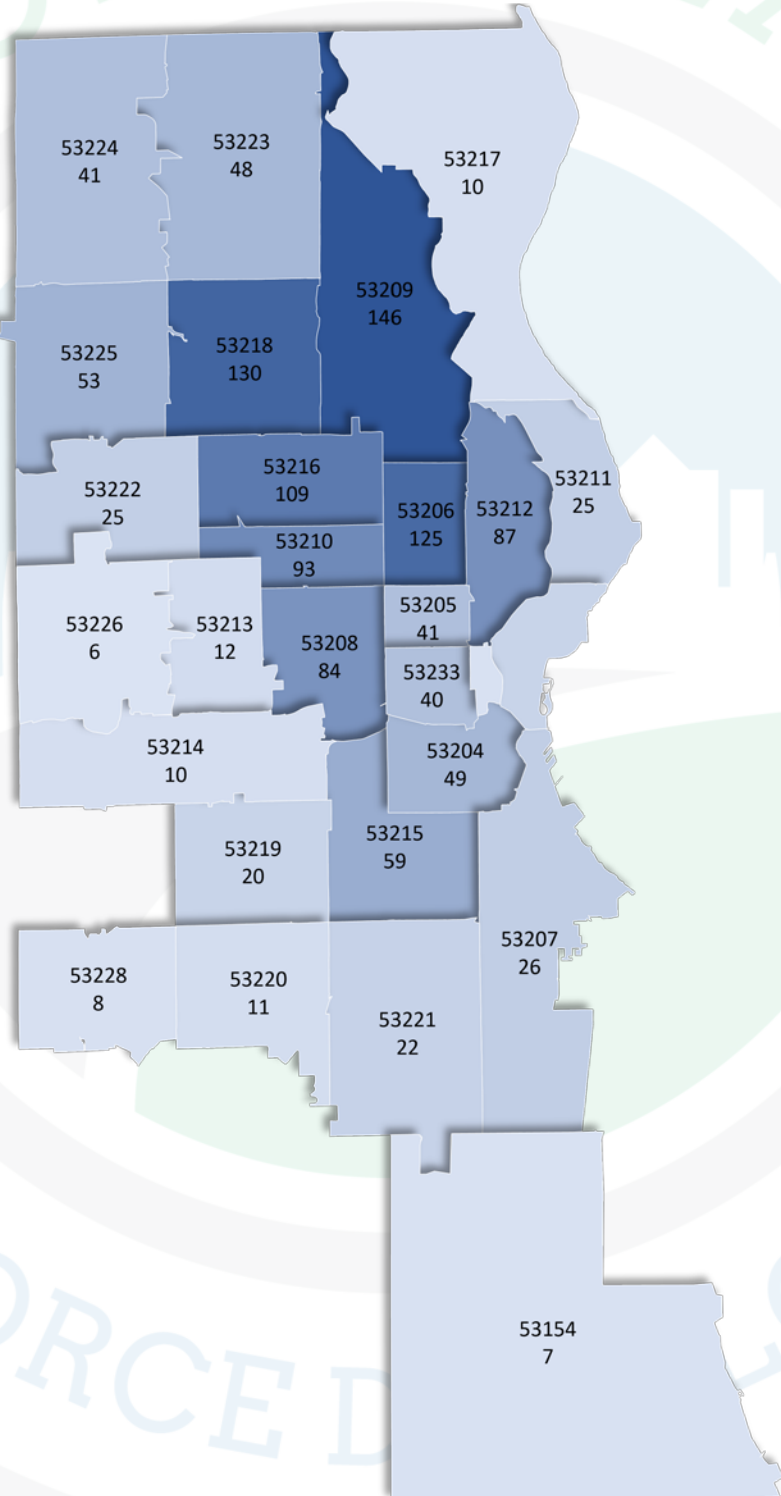
