Approval of this By the Committee resolution directs the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors be involved in planning for the disbursement of the funding provided by the American Rescue Act of 2021 and that the County will collaborate with its local municipalities and local partners to spend its funding efficiently and effectively. In addition, the resolution anticipates the Office of the Comptroller will be involved in the development of the proposed spending plan to ensure proper financial oversight, accounting, and audit of the funds to ensure it comports with federal and state laws, local ordinances, and best financial practices. The resolution also recognizes that the funding provided by the American Rescue Act of 2021 shall prioritize inclusion of the County's mission of racial and health equity and improving Milwaukee County's financial position through investment in infrastructure to support its employees and operations. Finally, the resolution requests the Department of Administrative Services to provide regular reports to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors as to the proposed plan to allocate the funding.

- C. This resolution does not have any budgetary impacts in the current or future years.
