- A. Approval of this resolution would increase the composition of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors to 21 elected members effective for the term beginning in 2022.
- B. There are no direct costs associated with this resolution. As noted in File Nos. 20-679 and 20-680, 2013 Wisconsin Act 14, among other things, established statutory limits on how much an individual Milwaukee County Supervisor can earn while also limiting the County Board of Supervisors' budget to 0.4 percent of the aggregate County budget. Under present law, expansion of the County Board's membership could not increase costs but likely would necessitate a reduction in salaries for County Supervisors and/or their staff budget.
- C. No budgetary impacts are expected in this or subsequent years. The resolution would not authorize the expenditure of any additional funds.
