4 **AN AMENDED & ENGROSSED RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE**

5
6 amending Chapter 47 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances related to
7 the establishment of trails within the Milwaukee County Parks System, including any
8 changes made to established trails
9

10
11 WHEREAS, the Kegel Alpha Mountain Bike Trail (the “trail”) located in Mangan
12 Woods at Whitnall Park in Franklin is one of five mountain bike trails in the Milwaukee
13 County Parks System **and is approximately 4 miles in length**; and
14

15 WHEREAS, the trail cannot be used when wet or when covered in snow, which
16 often requires frequent rerouting as weather conditions change; and
17

18 WHEREAS, instead of frequent rerouting depending on the season and weather,
19 the Milwaukee County Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) natural
20 areas team explored a permanent change that could be made to the trail to lessen trail
21 closures and provide clarity to trail users; and
22

23 WHEREAS, although the permanent trail rerouting plan includes some
24 intersection with hiking trails, there will be large trail segments that are noticed for
25 “biking only” or “hiking only”; and
26

27 WHEREAS, the trail changes will reduce forest fragmentation, provide more
28 intact habitats, and reduce erosion; and
29

30 WHEREAS, Mangan Woods is a unique and important natural area within the
31 Milwaukee County Parks System, containing some of the largest old-growth hardwoods
32 in the System; and
33

34 WHEREAS, managing the natural area is focused upon maintaining a limited
35 amount of hiking, biking, and dog-walking trails and preserving the natural habitat for
36 existing species; and
37

38 WHEREAS, on October 10, 2019, the DPRC held a public information meeting to
39 present the proposed trail changes and receive input from the public on the changes;
40 and
41

42 WHEREAS, construction on the permanent trail rerouting began in the fall of
43 2020; and
44

45 WHEREAS, Chapter 47.11 of the Milwaukee County Code of General
46 Ordinances regulates bicycle usage in Milwaukee County Parks and states:

47
48 “No person shall ride a bicycle upon the lawns, walks, or foot trails in the
49 parks or parkways except in areas designated for such use by the director
50 of the department of parks, recreation, and culture.”

54 WHEREAS, DPRC has a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Metro
55 Mountain Bikers, the Milwaukee chapter of the International Mountain Bicycling
56 Association, for maintenance, repair, and promotion of five mountain biking trails within
57 Milwaukee County, including the Kegel Alpha Mountain Bike Trail; and

58
59 WHEREAS, the Metro Mountain Bikers, in accordance with the MOU, assist
60 DPRC in executing trail improvements, which may include the changes made to the
61 Kegel Alpha Mountain Bike Trail; and

62
63 WHEREAS, establishment of new trails and significant changes to existing
64 trails shall be reviewed by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors, with
65 significant defined as changes that alter 20 percent or more of the existing trail’s
66 total length; and

67
68 WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of
69 April 13, 2021, recommended adoption of File No. 21-207 as amended (vote 3-2); now,
70 therefore,

71
72 BE IT RESOLVED, the establishment of new trails and any substantial
73 significant changes made to existing trails shall be the purview of the Milwaukee
74 County Board of Supervisors, with significant defined as changes that alter 20
75 percent or more of the existing trail’s total length; and

76
77 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director, Department of Parks,
78 Recreation, and Culture shall present to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors
79 any all trail creations, eliminations, or and all significant changes; and

80
81 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in the event that it is not clear whether or not
82 a trail constitutes a 20 percent overall change in the trail’s total length, the
83 Director, Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture shall consult with the
84 County Board Supervisor of the district where the proposed change is to occur
85 and receive input as to whether or not the change is considered significant; and

87 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any changes to the Kegel Alpha Mountain
88 Bike Trail shall require approval by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a temporary moratorium shall be placed on the use of any portion of the Kegel Alpha Mountain Bike Trail that was established in September 2020 or later by bikers, but the original trail, established prior to September 2020, can continue to be used for bike and foot traffic; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the temporary moratorium shall be lifted if the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors approves the new Kegel Alpha Mountain Bike Trail route; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby amends Chapter 47.11 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances by adoption of the following:

AN ORDINANCE

The Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 47.11 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

47.11. - Regulation of bicycle riders.

Riders of bicycles shall comply with the rules for the regulation of other vehicles, as stated in section 47.10 of the Code, and in addition thereto shall be subject to the following regulations:

- (1) No person shall ride a bicycle upon the lawns, walks or foot trails in the parks or parkways except in areas designated for such use by the director of the department of parks, recreation, and culture and approved by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors if a new trail is created, a trail is eliminated, or if an existing trail is significantly changed, with significant meaning the change alters 20 percent or more of the original trail's total length.
- (2) Riders shall proceed in the extreme right-hand lane of the drives at all times, in single file only.
- (3) Riding crosswise and curving to and fro are strictly prohibited.
- (4) No rider shall take both hands off the handles or ride recklessly in any other manner.
- (5) A bicycle shall not be towed by a rope or otherwise, nor shall any rider hold on to any moving vehicle for the purpose of being drawn along.
- (6) No bicycle shall be pushed upon any park or parkway drive where an adjoining footwalk is available.
- (7) Infants, children or extra passengers shall not be carried on bicycles in any manner whatsoever.

- (8) Children riding small bicycles, wheels less than twenty (20) inches in diameter, may use the footwalks.
- (9) Wherever possible, bicycles shall be parked in places provided for such purpose.

Section 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
