Transit Plus & MCTS Mobility Management Program 2020 Year in Review






 The Transit Plus program provides ADA compliant paratransit services to meet the public transportation needs of persons with disabilities while seeking opportunities for service excellence and innovation.





What is Paratransit?





- Door-to-door, shared ride service for those who's disability prevents them from using a fixed route bus.
- Rides are available anywhere in Milwaukee County and ¾ of a mile around bus route segments outside the county.
- ADA accessible van service provided under contract with First Transit and National Express Transit.
- American United Taxi provides same day service to Transit Plus under a separate discretionary contract.


Paratransit Additional Accomplishments


