A. DHHS is requesting authorization to execute a contract with the State of Wisconsin for the allocation of \$12,666,258 in federal Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) funding as well as accept an additional \$8,410,244 in direct ERA 2 funding from the Department of the Treasury.

B. Total 2021 expenditures and revenues included in this request are \$21,076,502. Emergency Rental Assistance funding may be used for rent, rental arrears, utilities and home energy costs, and other expenses related to housing incurred due to the pandemic

C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request as expenses are fully covered by ERA revenues.

D. This fiscal note assumes all expenditures incurred and revenues reimbursed will occur in calendar year 2021. The State's ERA 1 funding is authorized until September 30, 2022 and the direct federal earmark of \$8.4 million from the Treasury Department is authorized until September 30, 2025. Therefore, depending upon participant demand, some of this funding may need to carry over into future budget years.
