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From the Executive Director of Parks requesting approval of a development and maintenance agreement between Milwaukee County Parks and the South 27th Street Business District Association in Wilson Park, by recommending adoption of the following:

A REVISED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors adopted File No. 21-119, requesting that the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture enter into an Development and Maintenance Agreement with the South 27th Street Business District Association (BDA), for construction and maintenance of a new garden at Wilson Park (the Park); and

WHEREAS, the South 27th Street BDA is a non-profit organization that represents three Business Improvement Districts in Milwaukee and Greenfield; and

WHEREAS, the South 27th Street BDA has agreements with the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation, and the Cities of Milwaukee and Greenfield; and

WHEREAS, the South 27th Street BDA will construct walkways, garden beds, sculptures, and art installations in the Park, at an anticipated value of \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of May 11, 2021, recommended adoption of File No. 21-416 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) is hereby authorized to enter into a Development and Maintenance Agreement with the South 27th Street Business District Association (BDA) , for an initial term of three years, with three additional, three-year terms, for the construction and maintenance of a garden in Wilson Park (the Park); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director, DPRC, Department of Administrative Services, Office of Corporation Counsel, Risk Management, and any other department necessary, to prepare, review, approve, execute, and record all documents, and take all actions as required to execute the agreement with the South 27th Street BDA for the garden in the Park.
