

From the Director, Risk Management, requesting authorization to create Section 32.67 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances to require the Risk Management Division, Department of Administrative Services, to collaborate with the Office of Corporation Counsel to produce an annual report to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors by October 1 detailing liability insurance and claims costs by department, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Risk Management Division (RMD), Department of Administrative Services (DAS), is responsible for procuring or otherwise administering Milwaukee County's (the County) liability program, and the Office of Corporation Counsel (OCC) is responsible for the defense of lawsuits filed against the County; and

WHEREAS, the RMD-DAS was directed by the 2021 Adopted Budget to collaborate with the OCC to produce a report detailing liability program and claims costs by department annually by October 1; and

WHEREAS, the report shall include:

- Annual legal settlements and judgments pertaining to each department for the prior year and as much of the current year as is known at the time the report is produced
- A summary of each department's liability insurance premiums and a narrative which explains any changes in insurance costs

; and

WHEREAS, to effectuate the provisions in the 2021 Adopted Budget, an update to Chapter 32 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances (the Code) is required; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Safety, and General Services, at its meeting of June 10, 2021, recommended adoption of File No.21- 516 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, beginning in 2021, the Risk Management Division, Department of Administrative Services, in collaboration with the Office of Corporation Counsel, shall produce a report with corresponding data to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors by October 1 annually, which includes total County liability costs for the prior year and to date for the current year, detailing the following:
