Reopening of Senior Centers

It finally happened; we are back to pre-pandemic programming. On June 1st, the center opened offering programs that no longer had capacity limits and where physical distancing was not enforced. Reservations were no longer needed, but attendance was taken at each activity. People continued to utilize the hand sanitizer stations when they entered and left the building.

Now beginning July 1st, per the South Milwaukee Public Health Administrator and CDC guidelines, participants who are fully vaccinated—two weeks past their last shot—can participate in activities/programs without wearing a mask. To safeguard yourself and others, unvaccinated people are asked to continue to wear masks in the senior center. Also, if people feel more comfortable wearing a mask, please do. Per the city's Anti-Harassment and Retaliation policy, absolutely no harassment directed towards those that are or are not wearing face coverings will be tolerated.

One big change we rolled out in 2021 programming is food. Until further notice, people are asked not to bring/eat food while participating in any activity. As always, beverages are OK and straws are encouraged when seated close to others.
