Approval of this resolution would express support for 2021 Wisconsin Assembly Bill 141 and Senate Bill 251, or related legislation based on the Create a Respectful and Open World for Natural Hair (CROWN) movement. The movement relates to prohibiting discrimination of hairstyles which accommodate the hair of those with African ancestral origin. The resolution further requests the County Advisory Commission on Human Rights to review if County policies and procedures are consistent with the CROWN Act movement. Lastly, the resolution declares July 3, 2021 CROWN Day in Milwaukee County.
- B. There are no direct costs associated with this resolution. Existing staff time would be needed to communicate the contents of the resolution to State policymakers and the County Advisory Commission on Human Rights, and for the Commission to meet.
- C. No budgetary impacts are expected in this or subsequent years. The resolution would not authorize the expenditure of any additional funds.
