- A. The Director of the Office of Emergency Management is requesting to enter into a professional services contract with the Medical College of Wisconsin for a contracted Chief Health Policy Advisor. The County has taken on an increased role in health promotion, health equity, and pandemic response as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and as a result of the County's strategic plan and vision to achieve racial equity and to become the healthiest county in Wisconsin. These roles are expected to continue and a Chief Health Policy Advisor is proposed to be contracted out to take on these responsibilities.
- B. The cost of this contract is \$108,233.33 for a one year period from August 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022.
- C. Sufficient funds are budgeted in the approved allocation in File 20-937. This allocation provided \$5.0 million of authorized spending on COVID-19 response activities.
- D. The one-year contracted rate for the Chief Health Policy Advisor role is \$108,233.33.
