

## **Defining Racial Equity**

Racial Equity is defined as the *just* and *fair inclusion* of people of color in a society where <u>all</u> people can participate, prosper, and reach their full potential.

Racial Equity *is not the same* as Racial Equality. Equity is the *prerequisite* for achieving equality. Equity is *leveling the playing field* so everyone can equally access opportunity.

Racial Equity is both a *process* and an *outcome:* the process of understanding and prioritizing justice, fairness, and inclusion of people of color in decision making, and the outcomes that results from their engagement.






## Defining Community Engagement

Community Engagement is the iterative, interactive process of informing, listening to, involving, and empowering community members in decision making, with the goals of sharing power and generating public benefit.

Applying a racial equity lens to community engagement ensures the just and fair inclusion of community members most impacted by racial disparities in defining what they need to thrive and shifts power and resources to those communities to act on them.


