- A. If adopted, this resolution would abolish two vacant hourly Office Assistant positions and create two hourly Intern positions in the office of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors effective pay period 21, beginning October 3, 2021.
- B. Hourly positions do not generally have regularly scheduled hours and are therefore not funded on a per FTE basis, but rather through a pool of hourly funding appropriated in the budget. The County Board has a pool of funding appropriated for hourly Office Assistants, which would be used to fund any costs of the hourly Intern position. It is important to note that the County Board's budget is currently at the statutorily defined levy limit and no further appropriations may be established. Consequently, any costs that exceed the current funding pool for hourly positions within the County Board budget would need to be covered by other operational or salary savings within the County Board's budget resulting in no direct fiscal impact of this change.
- C. As stated above, the County Board's budget is currently at the statutorily defined levy limit and no further appropriations may be established. For the current year, any additional budgetary authority necessary for the hourly Intern positions would need to be absorbed within the current County Board's budget. For future year's funding, the County Board's statutorily defined levy limit will dictate how much budget authority is available for County Board salary and operations, including any pool of funding for hourly Intern positions.
