9 10 11	WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Zoo (the Zoo) is one of the top four attractions and largest cultural institution in the State of Wisconsin (the State); and
12 13	WHEREAS, the Zoo has a full-time staff of 152 employees, and an additional 200 seasonal and hourly employees during peak season; and
14 15 16	WHEREAS, the Zoo grounds lie on a 192-acre wooded campus, and is home to 2,213 specimens of 330 species; and
17 18 19	WHEREAS, the Zoo is open every day except Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day; and
20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, the Zoo was open for regular operations in 2020 through March 14, 2020; and
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, the Zoo was forced to close to the public due to the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic, the State, and local health department regulations; and
27 28 29 30	WHEREAS, the United States Small Business Administration (SBA) created the Shuttered Venues Operator Grant (SVOG) to provide emergency financial assistance for eligible venues affected by COVID-19; and
31 32 33 34	WHEREAS, funding is awarded to eligible venues based on revenue loss as a direct result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and
35 36 37	WHEREAS, the Zoo is an eligible venue for the SVOG opportunity, and incurred significant revenue loss due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
38 39 40	WHEREAS, the Zoo applied for the SVOG on April 8, 2021, and the SBA awarded the SVOG to the Zoo on August 8, 2021, without a local matching requirement; and
41 42 43	WHEREAS, the County will be the fiscal agent for the grant; and

WHEREAS, the SVOG of more than \$6.8 million will help the Zoo meet its 44 mission to continue to inspire public understanding, support, and participation in global 45 conservation of animal species and their environment, by creating a unifying bond 46 between visitors and the living earth, and will provide an environment for personal 47 renewal and enjoyment for guests; and 48 49 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of September 17, 2021, 50 recommended adoption of File No. 21-756 (vote 7-0); now, therefore, 51
