39 40 41	WHEREAS, the IRC was mindful of the Wisconsin redistricting case, <i>Baldus v.</i> <i>Members of the Wisconsin Government Accountability Board</i> , 849 F.Supp. 2d 840 (E.D. Wis. 2012), particularly Section 3.5: Voting Rights Act Claim of Latinos; and

42 WHEREAS, after due deliberation of many different maps drafted with the technical assistance of the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission 43 44 (SEWRPC), the IRC recommended three separate redistricting maps that were 45 ultimately rejected by the County Board of Supervisors, including: 46 47 Map E – Rejected 10/01/2021 in File No. 21-898 48 Map K – Rejected 10/13/2021 in File No. 21-955 49 Map L – Rejected 10/22/2021 in File No. 21-972 50 ; and 51 52 WHEREAS, Section 3.01(4)(e) of the MCGO states in part: "If the county board 53 does not adopt the proposed third draft map within five (5) days, the county board shall 54 proceed to develop and adopt a map directly, without further IRC consultation, following 55 procedures in s. 59.10(2)(a), Wis. Stats., and related provisions;" and 56 57 WHEREAS, upon the rejection of Map L, the third and final map from the IRC, 58 the County Board provided verbal feedback to SEWRPC staff as to the map alternatives 59 that could be presented to the County Board for review, selection, and approval; and 60 61 WHEREAS, the Executive Director of SEWRPC provided six different 62 redistricting maps to the County Board for their review and determination as to which 63 version, if any, should be adopted; and 64 65 WHEREAS, these versions include Maps J, K, L, K1, K2, and M to allow the 66 County Board several alternatives from which to choose a final map; and 67 68 WHEREAS, at its meeting on October 27, 2021, the Committee on Judiciary, 69 Safety and General Services reviewed the map alternatives and decided to recommend 70 either Maps K1 or M to the County Board of Supervisors for adoption (vote 5-0); now, 71 therefore, 72 73 BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to the criteria and specifications in Section 3.01 of 74 the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances, Wis. Stat. § 59.10, and relevant 75 case law, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts Maps K1 or M. hereby attached to this file, as the proposed redistricting plan for elections to the 76 77 Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for elections beginning in 2022; and 78 79 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board of Supervisors hereby 80 authorizes and directs the County Clerk and Office of Corporation Counsel, working in conjunction with other staff as needed, to transmit the approved map to municipalities in 81 82 Milwaukee County to develop local ward maps.
