Supervisors Will Hold Hearing on 2022 Budget

The Board of Supervisors will hold its official public hearing on the 2022 Milwaukee County budget next Monday, Nov. 1, at 6 p.m. The board's budget hearing is an opportunity for the public to speak directly to supervisors about the budget. There are several options for those who wish to participate. In the interest of promoting public health, the hearing will be held online. The recommended method for public participation is to join the meeting virtually using the Microsoft Teams app. People who wish to speak during the meeting are encouraged to register at Milwaukee.gov/CountyBoard. Public comment is limited to two minutes per person.

County Executive Crowley introduced his <u>2022 Recommended Budget</u> on Oct. 1. The Milwaukee County Comptroller released an <u>independent analysis and summary</u> on Oct. 8. The Committee on Finance will consider amendments to the recommended budget before considering an adopted budget on Nov. 8.
