13	WHEREAS, Microsoft Corporation (Microsoft) is a global leader in core business software, and Milwaukee County (the County) has been using various Microsoft
14 15	products since the early 1990's for running its business operations; and

10	WHEREAS, in anticipation of the required renewal of Microsoft product licenses
18	currently used by the various departments and divisions of the County, Crayon
19	submitted the lowest price quote, and was selected to provide software products under
20	the new Enterprise Agreement (Agreement) to the County; and
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22	WHEREAS, in the second quarter of 2021, the Information Management
23	Services Division (IMSD), Department of Administrative Services (DAS), hired a
24	consulting firm, Directions on Microsoft, to help negotiate the license fees with Crayon
25	and Microsoft under the new Agreement; and

27	WHEREAS, as a result of these negotiations, IMSD-DAS saved \$142,774.84
28	(compared to the amount originally quoted by Crayon) for the County over the three- year term of the Agreement; and

30 31	WHEREAS, negotiations took longer than anticipated due to the mission critical
ار 32	nature of these software products, which resulted in the expiration of the previous
33	Microsoft Agreement; and
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35	WHEREAS, IMSD-DAS requested, and Microsoft and Crayon agreed, to allow
36	the County to use these products until the new Agreement was approved by the County
37	Board; and
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39	WHEREAS, the new Enterprise Agreement is a three-year term, under which the
40	County is required to pay total fees not-to-exceed \$3,796,420.96, comprising of up to
41	\$1,244,795.79 for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022; \$1,275,812.58 for the
42	period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023; and \$1,275,812.58 for the period July 1,
43	2023, through June 30, 2024; and
