- B. The 2021 estimated cost of the pay increase which reflects salary and social security is \$23,446 based on an October 1, 2021 effective start date through December 31, 2021.
- C. The \$2.75 per hour premium pay proposal is to be funded by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act of 2021. A total of \$169,295 was awarded to Milwaukee County DHHS.
- D. A \$2.75 per hour premium pay increase is proposed for APS staff who are compliant with the Vaccine Order for Milwaukee County.
