During those conversations, new information has been provided pertaining to how marketing will be done for MHEC. As this new information still did not address the intent of the meeting, it raised more questions from members of the Miracle Group. The Council is adamant about continuing the collaboration with the Miracle Group in extending efforts to MHEC. It's believed the collaboration between the two will be more effective.
